

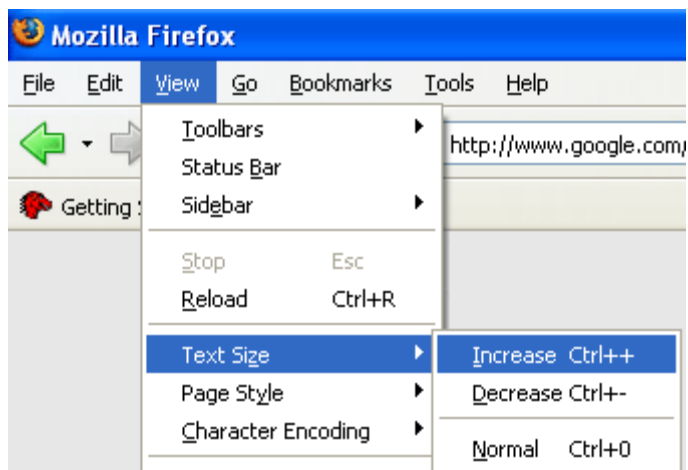
## Common Accessibility Questions:

### Adjusting the Text Size in the Browser

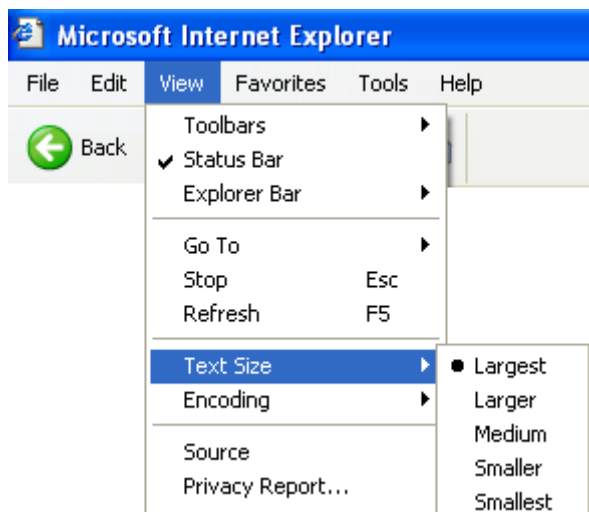
The text in my webCT courses and in accessBCC is small and hard to read. How can I make it larger?

You can increase the size of the text in your browser by going to the **View** menu and selecting **Text Size**.

In **Firefox** you Increase or Decrease the text size:



In **Internet Explorer** you can set the text size from medium to larger or largest:



**The text still seems small on the screen. Is there something else I can try?**

Most computer monitors are set to a high screen [resolution](#). Try decreasing the resolution by right-clicking on your desktop and choosing Properties. When you see the Display Properties appear select the Settings tab and decrease the resolution to 800 x 600. Click OK and the new resolution should take effect.
