A final grade of C or higher is required for any course to transfer to Bentley.

A maximum of 60 total credits may be transferred to Bentley.

A maximum of 6 credits may be applied to the major; a maximum of 3 credits may be applied to the minor.

Final transfer credits may vary based upon major chosen and corresponding electives. Business electives in particular may be limited for some majors.

*ACC 101, ACC 102, ACC 257, and BUS 253 combined will receive credit for GB 112 Tools & Concepts in Accounting & Finance, GB 212 Practice & Applications in Accounting & Finance, and FI 270 Managerial Finance; or can transfer ACC 101, ACC 102, and ACC 257 take Finance at Bentley to complete sequence

**for students transferring more than 45 credits and planning to major in Accounting- or Finance-related majors, need to transfer in MA 214 to help progress through degree requirements in a timely manner. MA 214 or 132 is strongly recommended for all other majors. Students need to take MA 131 and 132 to bring in the MA 123 and 126 Math sequence.
