Degree: Bachelor of Science in Project Management
And
Bristol Community College, Fall River, Massachusetts

Bristol Community College (BCC) is located at 777 Elsbree Street, Fall River, MA 02720. This college is accredited by NEASC and offers amongst other degrees, two-year associate degrees in:

- Civil Technology
- Automation Technology
- Environmental Technology
- Computer Information Systems Transfer
- Biomanufacturing Technology
- Electro-Mechanical Technology
- Business Information Systems
- Engineering Science Transfer
- Electronics Technology-Computers and Telecommunications

These degrees are considered for an articulation agreement that would enable students graduating from BCC with degrees in these programs to enter the Bachelor of Science in Project Management (PM) at The Arioich Center at Wentworth Institute of Technology (WIT) (see attached Table 1 for summary of transfer credit by program—this summary is based on individual students meeting the Terms of this articulation agreement outlined below).

Terms of articulation agreement

Students who have completed these programs at BCC will be accepted into PM bachelor's degree subject to the following conditions:

General Terms:

1. Students will enter in the fall or spring semesters.
2. This agreement is valid only for the Bachelor's in Project Management through The Arioich Center.
3. The student must have a GPA of 2.5 or better.
4. Only grades of 'C' or better will be accepted in the transfer.
5. No credit will be transferred for course work done by the student that is more than ten years old as of the date of admission to WIT.
6. This articulation agreement will initially be valid for a period of three years effective Fall 2009, and will be reviewed in Fall 2011 for renewal effective Fall 2013.


7. In case any changes are made to the curriculum in these programs at BCC these will be made known to The Arioeh Center as soon as they are finalized or implemented and The Arioeh Center may amend the articulation agreement as considered appropriate by The Arioeh Center. The Arioeh Center will notify BCC of any changes to the PM program that would affect this agreement.
8. The Arioeh Center Curriculum Advisory Board will review Humanities and Social Science courses from BCC for possible upper level credit. Currently students entering WIT under this articulation agreement must meet 3 upper level Humanities and 6 upper level Social Science credits. UMass Dartmouth and Bridgewater State College presently accept BCC courses for upper level credit¹ (see Appendix A for a list of courses). BCC will submit to syllabi from selected courses to The Arioeh Center for review; the Arioeh Center Curriculum Advisory Board will either:
 - a. Elect to transfer in these courses to meet upper level credits, or
 - b. Suggest to BCC revisions in order for the course(s) to meet upper level credit requirements at The Arioeh Center.
9. In order to fulfill The Arioeh Center graduation requirements the following curricular conditions must be met:



Curricular Terms:

- Students are required to take a minimum of 48 credits through The Arioeh Center; all these credits must be in the major.
- In addition to these 48-credits in the major in Project Management, students must meet General Education requirements by program (see Appendix B).
