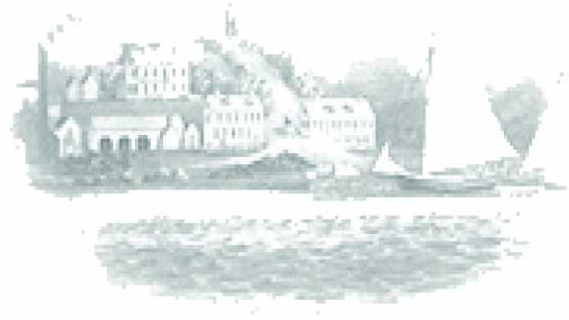

Bob Lee, Associate Professor in the American Civilization Department at Brown University, is one of the nation's foremost scholars of the Asian-American experience. His book, *Orientalism: Asian Americans in Popular Culture*, won the best book award from the New England Popular Culture/American Studies Association and best book on the social construction of race from the American Political Science Association. His most recent collection, *Displacements and Diasporas: Asians in the Americas*, explores the genuinely transnational Asian American experience.
