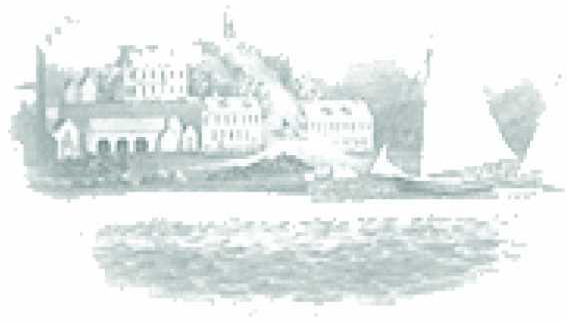

Ron Takaki is one of the most preeminent scholars of our nation's diversity. He is a professor of Ethnic Studies at the University of California, Berkeley, where the faculty has honored him with a Distinguished Teaching Award. Professor Takaki is the author of 11 books, including *Strangers from a Different Shore: A History of Asian Americans* (Little, Brown, 1989), selected by the New York Times as a Notable Book of the Year, and *A Different Mirror: A History of Multicultural America* (Little, Brown, 1993), the winner of numerous prizes, including the American Book Award. The Los Angeles Times has described Takaki as a "minority Everyman. He is a rare hybrid, a multicultural scholar."
